

# PHYC/SYC Women's Race

Saturday, August 24, 2019

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The series races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the "The Racing Rules of Sailing."
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) National Authority apply

### 2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A

### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Eligible yachts shall be entered by completing registration with the organizing authority according to the "Schedule of Events".
- 3.2 This event is open to women only. Except Coach fleet which may include male "Coach".
- 3.3 There is a \$25 fee for entry, due with registration.

### 4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Registration is due with fees by August 23, 2019.
- 4.2 Race sign up closes at 2000 on August 23, 2019
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1200 on August 24, 2019
- 4.4 Skippers meeting will take place at PHYC at 0930, Saturday August 24

### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available by August 23 and handed out at registration and posted at PHYC.

### 6 CLASSES

#### 6.1. Classes

- 6.1.1 PHRF - Yachts shall race in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-laws
- 6.1.2 JAM Class - Yachts shall race in accordance with Lake Huron PHRF By-laws. Yachts in this class may only sail with Jib and Main.
- 6.1.3 Coach Class - Yachts shall race in accordance with the Lake Huron PHRF By-laws. Yachts may only use Jib and Main in this class. Yachts may sail with one (1) coach on board. This class is intended for participants with limited racing experience.

## **6 CLASSES (continued)**

- 6.2 Registered yachts cannot change class after 2000 on August 23.
- 6.3 Fleet splits will be posted on official race board on Saturday, August 24.
- 6.4 Yachts without a Lake Huron PHRF rating will be assigned a rating by LHPHRF

## **7 THE COURSES**

- 7.1 The course will be a buoy course in the vicinity of the PHYC/SYC Octagon course.
- 7.2 See final S.I.s for course details.
- 7.3 A river course may be used if conditions in the lake require it. The change will be made 30 minutes prior to Skipper's Meeting.

## **8 PRIZES**

- 8.1 Flags will be given to the top three finishers in each fleet
- 8.2 Perpetual trophies will be awarded at the PHYC/SYC Awards Dinner in November

## **9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 9.1 Competitors participate in the races entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

## **10 INSURANCE**

- 10.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
